Poster Guidelines:

- Standard poster dimensions for this session will be 3 feet wide by 2 feet high (36 inches wide by 24 inches high); please note the NEW DIMENSIONS from previous years, which are specified to accommodate all posters to corkboard dimensions.
- Corkboards at MAA MathFest will be 8'w x 6'h (with presentation surface of approximately 8'w x 4'h)
- Two posters will be assigned to each corkboard side (with a total of four posters per corkboard), so please make sure to stay within the standard dimensions
- MAA will provide cork boards and affixing materials with which to pin posters.
- Posters should read from top left to bottom right, as though reading a page.
- Posters should contain a good contrast between the background color and the text color. Consider using a light color background and dark text.
- All text should be readable from a distance of 4-5 feet
- The material on the poster should be well-organized and easy to follow
- Images should be of high enough resolution to print out clearly.
