





STUDENT MAA AMC ENROLLMENT GUIDE

Step One: Open the Registration Form (New and Returning Students)

- The registration link should open to a page like this. If not, it is not the correct link, and you will need to speak with your competition manager (CM) who is giving the MAA AMC.



Step One: Open the Registration Form (Returning Students)



- You will be redirected to the AMC Student Portal Login Page.
- Log in using the email address (User ID) and password for the account you created when you first registered for the MAA AMC.
- If you can't remember your password, please click "Forgot your password?"

- If the password reset email is blocked by your school email system or you can't remember the email address used, ask your CM to reset your password (and check the email address used) from their registration page on last year's competition portal.

Reminder: Registration and Eligibility Rules

- AMC 10 & AMC 12: You can only register to take ONE of these competitions on each Competition Day. (E.g. either the AMC 10 A or the AMC 12 A, but not both).
- AMC 8: While we give CMs a week to administer the competition, you may only register to take the AMC 8 once. Please check with your school whether they will be hosting it before registering for it at another location. Scores will be cancelled for students taking AMC8 twice in the same year.
- ***Age Requirements***
 - To participate in the AMC 8, a student must be in grade 8 or below and also under 15.5 years of age on the day of the competition.
 - To participate in the AMC 10, a student must be in grade 10 or below and under 17.5 years of age on the day of the competition.
 - To participate in the AMC 12, a student must be in grade 12 or below and under 19.5 years of age on the day of the competition.
