



## **Editor of the *American Mathematical Monthly* – call for applications**

Founded in 1894, the *American Mathematical Monthly*, the flagship journal of the Mathematical Association of America (MAA), publishes high quality expository articles on a wide range of mathematical topics presented in an appealing expository style. The journal, which is published in collaboration with Taylor & Francis and indexed by Clarivate, is a leading periodical with a diverse international readership. The *American Mathematical Monthly* is a venue for excellence in expository mathematical writing as well as an important vehicle for realizing the mission of the MAA to advance the understanding of mathematics and its impact on our world.

The MAA now seeks candidates to serve as Editor of the *American Mathematical Monthly* starting in January 2027. The ideal candidate will have a proven track record of excellence in the teaching and/or exposition of mathematics at an undergraduate level or higher and should have broad mathematical interests, including the culture, history, and applications of mathematics. The five-year editorial term runs from January 1, 2027, to December 31, 2031.

Reporting to the MAA Senior Director of Publishing, the editor will manage a team of associate editors and lead an editorial board and will effectively coordinate both the submission and production procedures using established workflows. This work, which is expected to require the equivalent of approximately three days per week, will be supported by the MAA's Publications Operations Manager. The editor will also work closely with the MAA Senior Director of Publishing to grow and develop the journal in line with the MAA's publication strategy, while maintaining the highest editorial standards. Previous journal editorial experience, including familiarity with conducting and managing peer review and the journal publication process, while not necessary, is highly desirable.

The successful candidate will have a range of qualities including superb organizational and time-management skills, the ability and willingness to delegate effectively and to recruit and lead a team of associate editors and editorial board members, and exceptional communication and interpersonal skills. Candidates should display a clear commitment to advancing the MAA's core goals, as outlined at <https://maa.org/about/>.

The editorship of the *American Mathematical Monthly* is a pivotal and highly prestigious role in the intellectual life of the MAA that involves broad engagement with authors and readers from across the mathematical community and makes this a uniquely rewarding professional opportunity. The duties of the editor extend throughout the year and will involve promoting the journal at meetings and conferences such as the MAA's annual meeting, MAA MathFest. Financial support, largely in the form of course release time or a stipend, and travel reimbursements, will be provided.

To apply, candidates should submit a curriculum vitae, the names of three references, and a statement of relevant experience and interest in the position of editor of the *American Mathematical Monthly*. Review of applicants will begin March 15, 2026, with appointment as editor-elect to commence as soon as feasible.
