Call for Applications and Nominations

The **Mathematical Association of America (MAA)** seeks applications and nominations for the position of **Director of the William Lowell Putnam Mathematical Competition (the Putnam)**, widely regarded as the premier undergraduate mathematics competition in North America.

First held in 1938, the Putnam Competition has challenged generations of undergraduate students with problems that reward originality and deep mathematical thinking. Many of today's leading mathematicians first gained national recognition through their participation in the Putnam, making the competition an enduring tradition in the undergraduate mathematical community.

The Putnam Director provides leadership and management for the Competition and collaborates closely with MAA staff and the Putnam Associate Director to oversee its academic and operational success. Responsibilities include directing the Putnam Problems Committee, coordinating the development of the exam and solutions, planning and overseeing scoring, communicating with local supervisors, and helping promote the Competition within the mathematical community. The Director also curates Competition information on the MAA website, contributes messaging about procedures and deadlines, and prepares an annual report on the exam for publication in the *American Mathematical Monthly*.

The position includes compensation and may include support such as a course release, depending on the Director's home institution. The Director serves as a visible ambassador for the Competition and helps advance initiatives that strengthen its impact on undergraduate mathematics.
